Categories

Drawing competition:

- > Middle School Category: Grades 6- 7
- > Secondary School Category: Grades 8-10

Photography competition:

- > Secondary School Category: Grades 8-10
- > Higher Secondary School Category: Grades 11-12

Rules

Drawing competition:

- o No limitation on number of drawings a student can submit.
- o Size: A3 (May use drawing block paper)
- o Include below information on the back of the drawing.
 - > Title and brief summary of what the drawing portrays.
 - > Students' full name, age, class and school name.
- o Allowed to use variety of mediums including crayon, pencil, pen, water colour and paint.
- o Original drawings by students themselves with minimal assistance from teachers or other adults.
- o Drawings received may be used for MIRA's marketing purposes.

Photography competition:

- o No limitation on number of photographs a student can submit.
- o Landscape / Portrait
- o Color, Black and White, edited photographs are accepted (editing should not exceed beyond enhancement of the picture – color balance/sharpness/contrast)
- o In .jpeg, .jpg or .png format.
- o Include below information when submitting the photographs.
 - > Title and brief summary of what the photograph portrays.
 - > Students' full name, age, class and school name.
- o Original photographs by students themselves with minimal assistance from teachers or other adults.
- o Photographs received may be used for MIRA 's marketing purposes

Criteria

Creativity, Originality, Relevance

Entry deadline

Schools are to submit the drawings/photographs to MIRA by 14 July 2016.
Photographs can be submitted in a CD, or emailed to marketing@mira.gov.mv.

Prizes

Each category will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd place at MIRA's 6th anniversary function.
